IN THE MATTER OF AN EXTENSION OF TIME WITHIN WHICH TO BEGIN AND COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION AND MAKE COMPLETE APPLICATION OF WATER UNDER PERMIT NO. R-584 AND NO. 7400 IN THE NAME OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, BUREAU OF RECLAMATION

ORDER

EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The United States of America, Bureau of Reclamation, is the holder of permit No. R-584 for the storage of 75,000 acre feet of water from McKay and Birch Creeks and permit No. 7400 for the appropriation of the stored water for supplemental irrigation.

The Bureau has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation described in the permits has not been made, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

Planning studies on the Umatilla Basin have been completed, and construction of McKay Dam and Reservoir, with the exception of diversion from Birch Creek to the reservoir, has also been completed. Definite plans as to the Birch Creek diversion will not be available until December 1967.

It is believed that it will be consistent with public interest to grant the extension for which application has been made.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the time limits for beginning of construction, completion of construction and for complete application of water under the terms of permits numbered R-584 and 7400 be extended to October 1, 1968.
