Findings of Fact

- The Department issued an order approving transfer application T-9598 on January 21, 2004.
 The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 59, Pages 70 to 74. The Department also
 issued an order approving T-10037 on March 28, 2006. The order was recorded at Special
 Order Volume 68, Pages 176 to 179.
- 2. Both Final Orders diminished a portion of the water rights evidenced by Certificate 52828, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
- 3. As a result of the order approving T-10037, water right Certificate 81918 was issued by the Department to confirm the diminution from irrigation to supplemental irrigation of 17.21 acres of water rights.
- 4. The order approving the previous transfer, T-9598, also authorized the diminution of water rights. However, the Department did not cancel water right certificate 52828 or order the issuance of a new certificate to confirm those changes.
- 5. Certificate 81918 failed to describe the diminishment from irrigation to supplemental irrigation of 49.5 acres of water rights authorized by T-9598.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. Certificate 81918 is cancelled.
- 2. Water Right Certificate 83885 is issued to supersede Certificate 81918 and to correctly describe the total acres of water rights that were diminished to supplemental irrigation as a result of the final orders approving both T-9598 and T-10037.
