

OF A CHANGE IN THE POINT OF DIVERSION )  
OF WATER. )

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing that Emma Weber, the petitioner herein, is the holder of a water right under certificate 3370 issued under permit 3121 of the State Engineer, covering the right to appropriate 0.14 second foot of water from Sutton Creek, a tributary of the Powder River for the irrigation of 10.7 acres of land, under priority of September 20th, 1916; that the water under said right has heretofore been pumped from Sutton Creek in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 21 T. 9 S. R. 40 E., into a ditch, and thence conducted a short distance to the land to be irrigated; that the applicant now proposes to change the point of diversion of said water by diverting same from Sutton Creek at a point located in the Northwest corner of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 34 T. 9 S. R. 40 E., into the "Old Cemetery" ditch; that said applicant has the consent and permission of the present owners of the "Old Cemetery" ditch to the use of the same for the purposes of diverting the waters to which she is entitled to and upon her lands; and it further appearing that such change in point of diversion will be of advantage to the applicant, in that the water may be carried to the land by gravity instead of through a pump, and that no other rights will be injured by such change; NOW, THEREFORE it is hereby ORDERED that said change in point of diversion be, and the same is hereby approved.
