



3. The first right to be temporarily transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 92990 in the name of POTLATCH CORPORATION (perfected under Permit S-37150)

**Use:** IRRIGATION OF 133.59 ACRES

**Priority Date:** JULY 25, 1973

**Rate:** 3.51 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED UNDER THE RIGHTS PERFECTED UNDER PERMIT 37150 DOES NOT EXCEED 140.1 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

**Limit/Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**Limit/Duty:**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

7. Temporary Transfer Application T-12946 proposes to temporarily transfer water rights within the boundaries of Columbia Improvement District. The district was notified of the proposed temporary transfer and indicated that the district did not object to the transfer.

***Temporary Transfer Review Criteria***

8. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no evidence available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. A diversion structure and pumping facility, booster pumps and pipeline delivery system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights is present.
10. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights. The purpose of the proposed temporary change in place of use is to temporarily transfer water rights from drip irrigated strips to irrigated pivots containing row crops. Any use of water outside of the proposed pivots could be readily observed by the Watermaster, thus the need and use of soil moisture monitoring conditions described in the certificates will not be needed to monitor the proposed temporary place of use.
11. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights. This finding is made through an abbreviated review recognizing that the transfer may be revoked under ORS 540.523(5) if the Department later finds that the transfer is causing injury to any existing water right.


## Conclusions of Law

The temporary change in place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-12946 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.523 and OAR 690-380-8000.

**Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The temporary change in place of use proposed in Temporary Transfer Application T-12946 is approved.
2. The former place of use **shall not** be irrigated as part of these water rights during the 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 irrigation seasons.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2022 irrigation season.
4. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
5. A subsequent application for permanent transfer of Certificate 92990 and 92992 shall be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380. Approval of this temporary transfer does not establish a precedent for approval of a subsequent application filed for a permanent transfer.
6. The use of water at the temporary place of use authorized by this transfer shall be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 92990 and 92992.
7. The continued need for use of soil moisture monitoring conditions described in the above modified certificates will not be needed to monitor the proposed places of use to prevent enlargement of the rights. The conditions for soil moisture probes installation, monitoring and reporting are hereby removed from these water rights at the proposed place of use authorized in this transfer during the 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 irrigation seasons. The portions of the rights not modified by the final order shall retain the specific soil moisture monitoring conditions described in each certificate.
8. The time during which water is used under this approved temporary transfer does not apply toward a finding of forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
9. The use of the remaining water rights described by Certificates 92990 and 92992 shall continue to be in accordance with the terms and conditions of Certificates 92990 and 92992.
