ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On August 14, 2006, James E. and Mary Suzanne Bussard filed a transfer application to change the place of use under Certificates 76223, 76222, 80637, 51486, and 51487. The Department assigned the application number T-10228.
- 2. On January 11, 2007 Larry Toll, the applicant's agent, notified the Department of a scrivener's error in the listing of the source under Certificate 76223 in the Preliminary Determination. The source is correctly listed in this order.
- 3. The portion of the FIRST right to be transferred is as follows:

- 13. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 22, 2006, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 14. On January 5, 2007, the Department issued a preliminary determination proposing to approve Transfer T-10228 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the preliminary determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on January 9, 2007 pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
- 15. A portion of the proposed place of use under T-10228 for lands coming from Certificate 76223, 76222, 80637, 51486 and 51487 (being 13.49 acres in the NE ¼ NE ¼ of Section 11, Township 4 south, Range 12 east, W.M.) is already covered by existing water use Permit 50066. The transfer application indicates, however, that the lands under Permit 50066 described above will not be perfected. Therefore, a conflict between Permit 50066 and the incoming lands proposed by Transfer Application T-10228 will not occur.
- 16. Transfer Application T-10228 is being processed concurrently with transfer applications T-8080, T-9990 and T-10016 which also affect Certificates 51486, 51487, 76222, 76223, and 80637. Upon issuance of the final orders for these transfers, Certificates 51486, 51487, 76222, 76223 and 80637 will be cancelled and new certificates will be issued describing the portion of the rights not affected by the transfers.
- 17. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 18. Ditches, a pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right are present.
- 19. The Department requires a suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted under the rights. Currently the Badger Improvement District has a headgate and Parshall flume at the point of diversion that satisfies this requirement.
- 20. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 21. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-10228 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The changes in place of use proposed in application T-10228 are approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 80637, 76222, 76223, 51486, 51487, and any related decree.
- 3. Certificates 80637, 76222, 76223, 51486, 51487 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing the portions of the rights not affected by T-8080, T-9990, T-10016 and T-10228.
- The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before October 1, 2008. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- The former place of use of the transferred water shall no longer receive water as part of these rights.
- 6. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming the portions of the rights transferred will be issued.
