Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing that under the final decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County in the matter of the determination of the rights to the Wallowa River and its tributaries, there was allowed a water right from Hurricane Creek under the irrigation system of the Alder Slope Ditch Company for 4.5 acres in the SELSWI Section 30, and 5 acres in the NWINDI, and 12 acres in the NE-NW- Section 31 T. 1 S. R. 44 E., with priority of 1901: that said land is owned by Charles D. Emmons, one of the petitioners herein: that said land is situated at the extreme lower end of the Alder Slope Ditch, a mile below any other land irrigated from said ditch, and has been irrigated by means of a small ditch along a steep mountain side; that it is very difficult and expensive to conduct the water to said land, and it is proposed to discontinue the irrigation of said land and apply the water to 11 acres in the NEZNWZ Section 22 T. 2 S. R. 44 E., which land is owned by J. R. Brock, and is much more favorably situated with respect to the Alder Slope Ditch and can be more beneficially and economically irrigated therefrom than the first described; and it further appearing that such change in the use of the water will cause no injury to other rights, NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in place of use be, and the same is hereby approved.
