#### **Authority**

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right.

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. Water Right Transfer Application T-12938, in the name of LORI MAE MOSHER, AMANDA MAE MOSHER, and PHILLIP AUSTIN MOSHER was filed on May 30, 2018.
- 2. On September 25, 2019, Will McGill, Agent for the applicants, submitted a written request on behalf of the applicants asking that water right transfer application T-12938 be withdrawn.

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Transfer Application T-12938, in the name of LORI MAE MOSHER, AMANDA MAE MOSHER, and PHILLIP AUSTIN MOSHER, is withdrawn and is of no further force or effect.
