Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6666 submitted by

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 33128, was perfected under Permit G-1760 with a date of priority of JANUARY 18, 1961. The right allows the use of A WELL (WELL #3), a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 26.5 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 21, T.5S., R.3W., W.M.; 10 FEET NORTH AND 1190 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF ANGELL DLC, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 31652, was perfected under Permit G-1766 with a date of priority of JANUARY 30, 1961. The right allows the use of A WELL (WELL #4), a tributary of LAMBERT SLOUGH (WILLAMETTE RIVER) BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 68.0 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.78 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SE½ NW½, AS PROJECTED WITHIN ANGELL DLC 57, SECTION 21, T.5S., R.3W., W.M.; 17½ CHAINS NORTH AND 18½ CHAINS EAST FROM SW CORNER, ANGELL DLC 57, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The third right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 42144, was perfected under Permit G-3392 with a date of priority of AUGUST 5, 1966. The right allows the use of TWO WELLS (WELL #1 AND #2), a tributary of LAMBERT SLOUGH (WILLAMETTE RIVER) BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 252.4 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.38 cubic foot per second, BEING 1.27 CFS FROM WELL #1 AND 1.11 CFS FROM WELL #2, if available at the original wells; WELL #1 - SW% SW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN PETERS DLC 58, SECTION 21, WELL #2 - SE% SE%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN PETERS DLC 58, SECTION 20, T.5S., R.3W., W.M.; WELL #1 - 10 FEET NORTH AND 3160 FEET EAST, WELL #2 - 30 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST, BOTH FROM SW CORNER, PETERS DLC 58, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to ADD, AS ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION, ALL OF THE POINTS OF APPROPRIATION DESCRIBED ABOVE TO ALL OF THE WATER RIGHTS DESCRIBED ABOVE.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1997.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriations, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

Certificates 33128, 31652, and 42144 are canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming these water right will be issued.
