ORDER APPROVING A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.523, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TEMPORARY TRANSFER 8672 submitted by

LEON KUENZI (OF R&L KUENZI)
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SALEM, OREGON 97305.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 34625, was perfected under Permit G-2120 with a date of priority of APRIL 19, 1962. The right allows the use of A WELL, in the WOOD CREEK BASIN (LITTLE PUDDING RIVER), for IRRIGATION OF 34.8 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN WOODWARD DLC 96, SECTION 23, T 6 S , R 2 W, W.M.; 590 FEET SOUTH AND 2110 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, DLC 96, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing on the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

SW¼ SW¼ 1.7 ACRES
SE¼ SW¼ 14.6 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN WOODWARD DLC 96
SECTION 23

NE¼ NW¼ 16.0 ACRES
NW¼ NW¼ 2.5 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN WOODWARD DLC 96
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to TEMPORARILY change the place of use to:


NE¼ NW¼ 18.8 ACRES
NW¼ NW¼ 16.0 ACRES
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN WOODWARD DLC 96
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. This change is temporary. This change shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
2. The former place of use shall **not** be irrigated as part of this water right during the 2001 irrigation season.
3. The use shall revert to the authorized place of use at the end of the 2001 irrigation season.
5. The approval of this temporary transfer may be revoked or modified if the Department finds the change causes injury to any existing water right.
6. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
