On July 8, 1981, Dennis R. McCarthy submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question, for the irrigation of 10.0 acres, was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation District, with a date of priority of November, 1904. Transfers C-7 and C-39 changed the place of use of said right to 6.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 4.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right for the use of the waters of Squaw Creek for irrigation of 6.0 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 and 4.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 24, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM, with a date of priority of November, 1904, is canceled.
