On April 3, 1978, Dave Kennedy, partner of Green Villa Farms, submitted an affidavit stating that they are the owners of the land claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The claimed right in question is described in the Certificate of Registration recorded at Page GR-679, Volume 4, Ground Water Registration Records with a priority date of 1920. The registration claims the use of not to exceed 150.0 gallons of water per minute from a well located 1984 feet South and 424 feet West from the NE corner of Section 35, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 35, Township 7 South, Range 4 West, WM. The registration claims the use for irrigation of: The registration
