An affidavit was received from DOROTHY R. MARLOW, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 13136, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of one and one-half miner's inches per acre as measured at the point of diversion from the Little Walla Walla River, a tributary of Walla Walla River. The date of priority is 1880. The abandoned water right is for irrigation of 1.08 acres.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.08 ACRES SECTION 2 TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

More explicitly described as:

Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16, Block 57, Town of Freewater

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the portion of the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that Certificate 13136 is canceled and a new certificate be issued for that portion of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
