O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION

On August 16, 1937, an application was filed by Carmen Grino, James Grino and C. H. Miller for the approval of a change in place of use of water within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District.

In the adjudication proceedings involving the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Arnold Irrigation Company for the irrigation of, among other lands, 15 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 20 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M., through the Arnold Irrigation System from Deschutes River, said lands being owned by Carmen Grino and James Grino. The applicants herein propose to transfer 25 acres of said water right to 25 acres in the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 11 East, W. M., said lands belonging to C. H. Miller.

The Arnold Irrigation District having submitted its written approval of the proposed transfer, it appears that such change in place of use of water can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved, and that the water right appurtenant to 15 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 10 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M. be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 25 acres in the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 11 East, W.M.

And it is FURTHER ORDERED that said water right so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use within the time fixed for completion of inchoate rights in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries.
