ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE, PLACE OF USE,
AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6822 submitted by

BEN AND ROSEALMA L. CORWIN
728 NW 5th
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DOUGLAS County as evidenced by Certificate 9620. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1908.

The right allows the use of COW CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION 2.2 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.03 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$	0.6 ACRE
NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$	1.6 ACRES

SECTION 5

TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to change the character of use and place of use of 0.4 acre of irrigation, being 0.005 cfs, tabulated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, to DOMESTIC USE in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

The applicant also proposes to change the point of diversion to the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 5, T 32 S, R 4 W, WM; 630 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 5.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995. *Get the...*
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 9620 is cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
