ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 5869 submitted by

NORMA L. QUICK (WESTLAND IRRIGATION DISTRICT)
ROUTE 6, BOX 6046
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

to use the waters of UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 28.2 ACRES.

The right to be transferred was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR in Volume 15, at page 440. The date of priority is JULY, 1907.

This right is limited to 0.70 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, WESTLAND CANAL: SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 3 N, R 29 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 16, T 4 N, R 28 E, W.M.; 660 FEET NORTH AND 10 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 6.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 4.2 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 24.0 ACRES
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.



THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
