Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, on the application of the Santiam Reclamation Company and the Willamette Valley Irrigated Lands Company for an extension of time in which to complete construction work under Enlargement Permit No. E 82 and Permit No. 1401, and <sup>it appearing</sup> that the time as heretofore fixed for the completion of such rights expired October 1st, 1920; that after full hearing on this matter held in Salem, Oregon, January 15, 1925, the State Engineer is of the opinion that a sufficient showing of diligence in the completion of this appropriation has been made;

And the State Engineer being of the opinion that the right of any owner of land in this State to appropriate water for the irrigation of his own land is inherent, will approve the application of Henry C. Porter, Trustee, and others for a permit to appropriate water, being numbered 9789.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said Santiam Reclamation Company and the Willamette Valley Irrigated Lands Company shall have until October 1st, 1926, within which to complete said rights; and be it further ORDERED that the application of Henry C. Porter be duly approved when the same has been completed so as to conform to the regulations of this office.
