ORDER

Now, at this time, the above entitled matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of Laura A. Dodson for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from North Powder River, and it appearing;

That by decree of the circuit court for Union County, dated May 1, 1916, a water right was recognized in the name of Laura A. Dodson, for the irrigation of 30 acres in the SW2 NE2, 30 acres in the SE2 NW2, 40 acres in the SW2 SE2 and 37 acres in the NW2 SE2, Section 55, Township 6 South, Range 38 E.,W.M., of which 53 acres has a date of priority of 1865, 140 acres a date of priority of 1873 and 21 acres a date of priority of 1886, to be conveyed through the Old Powers Power Company and J. L. Dodson ditches, from North Powder River;

That, of the above described lands, 16 acres in the SW NEL,

38 acres in the SE NW2, 2 acres in the NEL SW and 10 acres in the NW2

SE2, Section 35, are irrigated from the Old Powers ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located within the NEL NEL Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 38 E., W. M., and that the applicant herein proposes to change this point of diversion to the NEL NEL Section 38, same township and range:

That he change in point of diversion is less than one-quarter mile, and that there are no intervening diversions between the present point of diversion, and that such transfer will not be an injury to existing rights;

And it further appearing that Mr. Bent Landreth, water master, made a personal inspection of the proposed change in point of diversion and

recommends that such change be approved.

Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in point of diversion be and the same is hereby approved.
