ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6125 submitted by

RAYMOND S. AND JEAN N. BELNAP
4137 KOCHSMEIER ROAD
VALE, OREGON 97918

to use the waters of A SUMP in the WILLOW CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 4.5 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 41551, was perfected under Permit G-4851 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 17, 1970. The right is limited to 0.056 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 1, T 18 S, R 44 E, W.M.; 520 FEET SOUTH & 1550 FEET EAST FROM N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1.4 NE 1/4 4.5 ACRES
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.


THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
2. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
3. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) 2.0 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.5 ACRES
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 41551 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
