ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6363 submitted by

DESCHUTES RECLAMATION AND IRRIGATION COMPANY P.O. BOX 5126
BEND, OREGON 97708
FOR BRUCE AND GARY BARRETT

to use the waters of the DESCHUTES RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 1.0 ACRE.

The right to be transferred was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County as evidenced by certificate 29054. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR in Volume 16, at page 161. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 1, 1899.

This right is limited to: 0.007 cubic foot per second during April and October; 0.009 cfs May 1 to May 15 and September 15 to October 1; and 0.017 cfs May 15 to September 15, if available at the original point of diversion: Swalley Irrigation Lateral - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 17 S, R 12 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the river.

The new point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 17 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 364 FEET NORTH AND 621 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to the rate and duty, without ditch losses, established by the decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County dated March 24, 1933.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.0 ACRE SECTION 17 TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1991.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

When proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of the completed change is received, the change shall be considered perfected. At a later date, a new certificate shall be issued to the Swalley Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District.
