Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On July 29, 2005, Harvey and Vickie Childress filed an application to change the points of appropriation and place of use under Certificates 22861, 26875, 40196, 76187 and Permit S-43956. The Department assigned the application number T-9986.
- 2. On December 19, 2001, T-7585 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, page 1354. This order modified Certificate 76187.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 3. On December 28, 2001, T-8315 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, page 1403. This order modified Certificate 76187.
- 4. On August 22, 2006, T-8921 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 69, page 643. This order modified Certificate 76187.
- 5. On October 20, 2006, T-9658 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 70, page 360. This order canceled Certificate 76187. Certificate 82202 superseded Certificate 76187.
- 6. On April 24, 2009, T-10790 (Temporary Transfer) was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 77, page 578. This order modified Certificate 82202. The temporary transfer application expires at the end of the 2011 irrigation season.
- On August 17, 2009, T-10086 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 78, page 672. This order canceled Certificate 82202. Certificate 85703 superseded Certificate 82202.
- On September 25, 2009, T-9297 was approved and recorded in Special Order Volume 78, pages 980-984. This order modified Certificate 85703.
- On October 23, 2009, an order was issued withdrawing, reconsidering and superseding the order recorded at Special Order Volume 78, pages 980-984. The superseding order was recorded in Special Order Volume 79, pages 120-125. This order canceled Certificate 85703 and Certificate 85839 was issued.
- 10. Certificate 85839 superseded Certificates 76187, 82202 and 85703.

13. There were two scriveners errors found in Certificate 85839. The place of use in Section 24, T 40 S, R 18 E in the SE1/4 listed on the prior Certificate 85703 was excluded when Certificate 85839 was issued. There was also an error found in T 40 South, R 18 East, SW1/4 NW1/4, Section 1. Transfer application T-7160 transferred 2.44 acres from the authorized 4.87 acres, leaving 2.43 acres that were not affected by the transfer. Certificate 85839 lists an incorrect figure of 2.40 acres. The following table lists the corrected place of use.

15. A scrivener's error was found in Certificate 26875. The Certificate says that the right is for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. Correspondence in the water right application file shows that Elmo Angele submitted Application S-24791 for IRRIGATION. The Department's records show no other water rights filed within the place of use for this right, however Permit S-24489 was issued for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. Certificate 26875 was subsequently issued for supplemental irrigation, perpetuating the error, even though there was no other irrigation water right on the place of use. Considering that there is no evidence for the right to have been supplemental to another right at any time in its history, the Department considers the designation of "supplemental" to be a scrivener's error that should be corrected. Certificate 26875 should state that the right is for IRRIGATION.

- 25. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 16, 2005, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000 comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 26. On June 21, 2006, a draft Preliminary Determination was issued to deny T-9986 due to the potential for enlargement. There was a discrepancy in the total acres proposed for Certificate 76187 and Supplemental Permit S-43956.

- 27. On January 1, 2007, the water right examiner requested approval to use a non-standard scale pursuant to OAR 690-380-3100 (E) on the amended transfer application map for T-9986.
- 28. On January 2, 2007, an amended application map was submitted for T-9986. The discrepancy identified in the June 21, 2006, draft Preliminary Determination identified in Finding of Fact # 26 was corrected.
- 29. On January 11, 2007, the Watermaster sent an e-mail to the water right examiner discussing an additional water right conflict that he found with certificate 26875 and the proposed place of use under Certificate 76187 and Permit S-43956.
- 30. On January 31, 2007, a second draft Preliminary Determination was issued to approve T-9986. It addressed an underlying water right conflict within the authorized place of use identified in Certificate 26875 and the proposed place of use under Certificate 76187 and Permit S-43956.
- 31. On January 31, 2007, a letter was sent to the applicant requesting consent from the new landowners who purchased property previously owned by Harvey and Vickie Childress, applicants for T-9986.
- 32. On February 13, 2007, the Department received a letter of consent from Charles Drinkwater and Harvey Childress, approving the changes made in the application and application map for T-9986.
- 33. On February 1, 2010, the Department received a modified application and map resolving the water right conflict addressed in Finding of Fact #29 and the second draft Preliminary Determination in Finding of Fact #30.
- 34. On February 8, 2010, the department received an e-mail from David and Jody Jones, owners of the property previously owned by Harvey and Vickie Childress, consenting to the changes requested in T-9986.
- 35. On February 8, 2010, a letter was sent to Harvey and Vickie Childress requesting review and approval of the modification of the application and application map for T-9986.
- 36. On March 19, 2010 the department received an amended application from Harvey and Vickie Childress requesting that David and Judy Jones be the receiving landowners of their portion of the transfer.
- 37. On March 31, 2010, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-9986 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of April 30, 2010, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer.

38. On May 14, 2010, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-9986 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on May 18, 2919, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 39. Water has been used within the five-year period prior to submittal of the transfer application according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 40. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-9986.
- 41. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 42. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in points of diversion, place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-9986 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000 and the scrivener's error in Certificate 26875 is corrected.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The changes in place of use and the change in point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-9986 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Permit S-43956, Certificates 22861, 26875, 40196 and 85839 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 22861 and 26875 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing the portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The certificate issued to describe the portion of Certificate 26875 not affected by this transfer will correct the scrivener's error by stating the use as "irrigation", rather than "supplemental irrigation".
- 5. Water right Certificate 85839 is modified. The Department will issue a superseding certificate describing those modifications when determined it is necessary for record keeping and will complete the processing of pending transfers T-10810 and T-10894 which also modify Certificate 85839.

- 6. Permit S-43956 is modified. The Department will issue a certificate describing those modifications when determined it is necessary for record keeping.
- 7. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 8. The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device at the new point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device.
- 9. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 10. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2011**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 11. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued. A certificate issued to confirm the portion of Certificate 26875 affected by this transfer will correct the scrivener's error by stating the use as "irrigation", rather than "supplemental irrigation".
