On May 16, 1966, C. A. McCarty filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of changes in points of diversion and places of use of water from John Day River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

In the John Day River Adjudication proceedings a water right was established in the name of William Nichols evidenced by certificate 25632 for the use of the waters of John Day River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 20.3 acres in SUM NEW, 17.1 acres in SEM NEW, 32.8 acres in SUM NUM, 40.0 acres in SEM NUM, 10.0 acres in NEM SUM, 30.0 acres in NUM SUM, 17.7 acres in NEM SEM, 5.0 acres in NUM SEM, 6.7 acres in SUM SEM, and 10.4 acres in SEM SEM, Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M. and Federal Land Bank evidenced by certificate 25162 for the irrigation of 8.8 acres in SEM SUM, Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 25 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905.

These lands under certificate 25632 are irrigated from a point of diversion located 1930 feet South and 30 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within the NE% SE% of Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., and the lands under certificate 25162 are irrigated from a point of diversion located 2900 feet South and 520 feet East from the NW corner of Section 9 being within the NW% SW% of Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described. proposes to chance the place of use of the irrication of 12.8 acres in SWA NWA, 3.0 acres in SEA NWA, 1.0 acre in NEW SWA, 12.0 acres in NWW SWM. 5.2 acres in SWW SEW. and 3.1 acres in SEW SEW. Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905, to 18.4 acres in SWA NEW, 0.9 acre in SEWA NEW, 10.3 acres in NEW SEW, and 7.5 acres in NWW SEW. Section 5. Township 9 South. Range 25 East, W.M., and irrigate these lands together with the balance of the land from three points of diversion to be located: 2290 feet South and 330 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within the NEW SEW of Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., 720 feet South and 720 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within Lot 1 (SE% NE%), Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., and 957 feet North and 4686 feet West from the SE corner of Section 33 being within the SWM of Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 25 East. W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed changes in points of diversion and places of use of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Fossil, Oregon, on May 27, 1968 at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in The Journal, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wheeler County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 25, May 2 and 7, 1968. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Wayne J. Overcash, Watermaster of District No. 4, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed changes in points of

diversion and places of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in use and points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it here'y is ORDERED that the change in places of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 12.8 acres in SWA NWA, 3.0 acres in SEA NWA, 1.0 acre in NEA SWA, 12.0 acres in NWA SWA, 5.2 acres in SWA SEA, and 3.1 acres in SEA SEA, Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 18.4 acres in SWA NEA, 0.9 acre in SEA NEA, 10.3 acres in NEA SEA, and 7.5 acres in NWA SEA, Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the pr_posed changes in points of diversion of water from John Day River, to-wit:

From a point located 1930 feet South and 30 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within the NE% SE% of Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East. W.M.

From a point located 2900 feet South and 520 feet East from the NW corner of Section 9 being within the NWA SWA of Section 9, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 2290 feet South and 330 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within the NE% SE% of Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 720 feet South and 720 feet West from the NE corner of Section 5 being within Lot 1 (SEM NEM), Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 38.7 acres in Lot 2 (SWM NEW), 18.0 acres in Lot 1 (SEW NEW), 15.0 acres in Lot 4 (SWM NEW), 37.0 acres in Lot 3 (SEM NEW), 9.0 acres in NEW SWM, 18.0 acres in NEWA SWM, 28.0 acres in NEWA SEM, 12.5 acres in NEWA SEM, 1.5 acres in SWM SEM, and 7.3

acres in SEM SEM, Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., and 8.8 acres in SEM SEM, Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 25 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905, and

To a point to be located 957 feet North and 4686 feet West from the SE corner of Section 33 being within the SWA SWA of Section 33, Township 8 South, Range 25 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 5.0 acres in Lot 4 (SWA NWA), Section 5, Township 9 South, Range 25 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1905, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use and the change in point of diversion made on or before October 1, 1969.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old points of diversion and shall be limited to 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month; total of five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headqutes and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right heretofore issued to William Nichols and recorded at page 25632, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates and to Federal Land
Bank and recorded at page 25162, Volume 17, State Record of Water
Right Certificates, are canceled and in lieu thereof new certificates
be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer
of completion of the authorized changes in points of diversion and
places of use, certificates of water right shall be issued to C. A.
McCarty confirming the extent to which the water has been applied
beneficially and the changes in points of diversion.
