On March 3, 1995, an affidavit was received from LUCILLE VELAQUEZ, 11595 NW Gales Creek Road, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, the owner of certain land and the water right appurtenant to it. The water right has been abandoned and is requested to be canceled.

The abandoned water right is a portion of the right described by Certificate 46644, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The abandoned water right is for the use of 0.003 cubic foot per second from GALES CREEK in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN. The date of priority is JULY 29, 1974. The abandoned water right is for DOMESTIC USE.

A description of the place of use of the abandoned right is as follows:

SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the water right described herein is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate 46644 is canceled. It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right not involved in this proceeding.
