ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6224 submitted by

GEORGE C. SUTTON P.O. BOX 1114 HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

to use the waters of A WELL in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 10.0 ACRES.

The right to be transferred was perfected under Permit G-7375 with a date of priority of JUNE 2, 1977. The right is limited to 0.12 cubic foot per second of water, if available at the prior point of appropriation: NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 5 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1600 FEET NORTH & 750 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 31, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 5 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH & 200 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 10.0 ACRES SECTION 31 TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change is complete. The claim of beneficial use shall be submitted in accordance with the transmittal letter.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
- 3. Prior to using water under this right the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Transfer 5408 authorized a change in point of appropriation for this right based on proof to the satisfaction of the Director without a certificate being issued. This transfer authorizes the return to the original point of appropriation. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
