On March 23, 1951 the Snow Creek Irrigation District of Bend,
Oregon filed an application for the approval of a change in place of use
of water from Snow and Three Creeks and water stored in Big and Little
Three Creeks Lakes, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

Certificate of water right issued to the Snow Creek Irrigation
District and recorded at page 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, confirms a right under Permit No. 12458 for the irrigation
of, among other lands, 14 acres in the SE4 NW4, Section 18, Township 16
South, Range 11 East, W. M., from the direct flow from Snow and Three Creeks
with a date of priority of March 8, 1923 and storage in Big and Little Three
Creeks Lakes with a date of priority of September 12, 1936.

The applicants herein, owners of the above described land, propose to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 14 acres in the SW, WW, Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water from Snow and Three Creeks and from storage in Big and Little Three Creeks Lakes be and the same hereby is approved, and that the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 14 acres in the Ship NWa, Section 18, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 14 acres in the SWa NWa, Section 10, Township 16 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby shall be completed on or before October 1, 1952, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of the complete application of water to beneficial use, as provided herein, a certificate shall be issued to the Snow Creek Irrigation District to supersede the certificate heretofore issued to said district and recorded at page 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
