ORDER

The City of Astoria is the holder of permit No. R-2568 which grants a right to construct Young's Reservoir and storage therein of 12,000 acre feet, permit No. 27092 which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 26.0 cubic feet per second of water from Young's River and the reservoir for municipal use and permit No. 7257 which grants a right to the use of not to exceed 23.0 cubic feet per second of water from Young's River for municipal purposes.


The time for beginning of construction under the permits expired October 1, 1974.

The City has completed an engineering study and report on all water resources in Clatsop County. Current water demand and present economic conditions do not justify the expenditure to increase supply capability at the present time, but the City desires to preserve the right for future anticipated development.

It is considered by the State Engineer that the preservation of the right in question is consistent with the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits for beginning and completion of construction under permit No. R-2568 and for beginning and completion of construction and complete application of water under permits Nos. 27092 and 7257 are extended to October 1, 1979.
