- 1. The Department issued an order approving T-9256 on May 26, 2004. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 60, Pages 139-142.
- 2. The order incorrectly cited Certificate 80644 as describing the remaining right from Certificate 41322; that certificate number was already in use. Thus, Certificate 81005 describes that remaining right instead.
- Remaining right Certificate 80645 indicated incorrect address information. Certificate 81006 lists address information correctly, and supersedes Certificate 80645.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The order approving T-9256 as recorded in Special Order Volume 60, Pages 139-142 is corrected as described above.
- 2. All other provisions of the order are unchanged.
