O R D E R  
APPROVING APPLICATION

On December 12, 1941, E. D. Robinson of Sisters, Oregon, filed an application for approval of a change in place of use of water within the boundaries of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District.

By decree of the Circuit Court for Crook County, in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek and its tributaries, a water right was recognized for the irrigation of 33.5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and 35 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1904.

The applicant herein, owner of the above-described lands, proposes to transfer the water right appurtenant to 27 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 13 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., without loss of priority to 13 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, and 27 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

Notice by publication as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides that notice is not required in applications for only a change in place of use of water.

The Squaw Creek Irrigation District having approved the application and it appearing that the proposed change may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and that the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 27 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 13 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, W. M., having a date of priority of 1904, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 13 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 29, and 27 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that complete application of water to beneficial use upon the lands to which the water hereby is transferred shall be made on or before October 1, 1943, or such extension of time as may be granted by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
