



USE OF WATER, UNDER PERMIT NO. 2163)

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer, and it appearing that on December 30, 1922, an order was entered by the State Water Board of Oregon allowing the Highland Ditch Company an extension of time under Permit No. 2163, and withholding approval of changes in the place of use of the water appropriated under said permit until such time as the Company had completed its appropriation and submitted final proof; and it now appearing that said appropriation has been completed and final proof of appropriation submitted, and that changes in the place of use of the water from the lands covered by the permit, to the lands which have actually been irrigated, may be made without injury to other rights; and it further appearing that said Company should be granted an extension of time so that its rights may be in good standing, NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the changes which have been made in the place of use of the water appropriated under said permit be and the same are hereby approved, and the time for complete application of such water to the proposed use, is hereby extended to January 1, 1925.
