ORDER

The Oak Lodge Water District is the holder of permit No. 35297 which grants the right to appropriate not to exceed 62.0 cubic feet per second of water from Clackamas River for municipal use.


The District has advised that the appropriation has not been made as described in the permit, but it is the District's desire to preserve the right for this development.

The District has further advised that planning is in progress to provide for present and future needs of District residents and North Clackamas County residents, but financing for individual or joint pumping and treatment of water has not been completed, consequently, an extension of time will be required.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant said extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits to begin and complete construction and make complete application of water under permit No. 35297 be extended to October 1, 1977.
