On July 25, 1978, Gerald W. and Robert H. Belozer submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 22314, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of J.A. Bush, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream, with a date of priority of July 1, 1949, for irrigation of:

2.8 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Fackler DLC 43
17.4 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Fackler DLC 43
9.2 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Hall DLC 47
1.3 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Hall DLC 47
1.8 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Fackler DLC 43
Section 7

2.4 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Hall DLC 47
11.2 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Hall DLC 47

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 22314, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
