That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 51 gallons of water per minute from a well located 40 feet South and 600 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M., being within the NE4 NE4, Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 10.9 acres within the NE4 NE4 and 0.6 acre within the NW4 NE4, Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

That part of the claimed right described in said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 119 gallons of water per minute from a well located 40 feet South and 600 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 25.1 acres within the NE4 NE4 and 1.4 acres within the NW4 NE4, Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M., is not in question in this proceeding.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 51 gallons of water per minute from a well located 40 feet South and 600 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being withir the NE4 NE4, Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2

West, W.M., for the irrigation of 10.9 acres within the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ and 0.6 acre within the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 19, Township 5 South, Range 2 West, W.M., described in certificate of registration recorded at page GR 2409, Volume 10, Ground Water Registration Record, is canceled.
