Findings of Fact

- 1. On August 28, 2006, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right from H. J. Hanscom & Terry Hanscom.
- 2. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-8719 on December 6, 2002, issued in the name of H. J. Hanscom & Terry Matlock. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 56, at Page 2113. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2004.
- 3. The applicant has installed the pump at the proposed pumping station, which was powered by a power-take-off on a tractor. The applicant has 36.2 acres irrigated. The power-take-off was temporary, until a permanent electric power source can be installed.
- 4. To fully complete the change, the applicant needs to install a 15 horse powered 3 phase electric motor on a pump at the pumping station and to irrigate the 9 acres at the new place of use.
- 4. The applicant has requested that the time for completion be extended to October 1, 2007.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-8719.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of the change in place of use and an additional point of diversion, authorized by T-8719, shall be extended to October 1, 2007.
