On November 24, 1980, the Church of Scientology submitted an affidavit that the Church is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the Church has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 22394, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Otto W. Heider, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second of water from South Yamhill River, with a date of priority of March 30, 1953, for irrigation of a certain:

11.5 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Graves DLC 42
0.4 acre in Lot 1 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
2.3 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Chapman DLC 41
2.9 acres in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Graves DLC 41
0.5 acre in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Graves DLC 42
5.2 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Chapman DLC 41
0.3 acre in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Graves DLC 42
6.9 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Chapman DLC 41
2.1 acres in Lot 1 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)
Section 34
Township 5 South, Range 6 West, WM

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 22394, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
