O R D E R
REDUCING ACREAGE AND
EXTENDING TIME

Under date of December 31, 1941, Mr. B. L. Dodge transmitted to the State Engineer an amended map with a letter authorizing a reduction of the acreage to be irrigated under his Permit No. 298, covering a use of water from Rogue River, to 657.3 acres in Sections 7, 8, 17, 18 and 20, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W. M., and


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Permit No. 298 in the name of B. L. Dodge be amended as authorized and in conformity with the amended map, to cover the irrigation of not more than 657.3 acres of land.

The time for completion of construction and complete application of water under Permit No. 298, as extended, expired October 1, 1940.

A field examination of the project represented by this permit indicates that, considering all the facts connected with the proposed appropriation, reasonable diligence has been exercised in the prosecution of work under the permit, and

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the time for completion and complete application of water be extended to October 1, 1942, for the reduced acreage of 657.3 acres, as provided by Section 116-424, O. C. L. A.
