**Authority**

ORS 540.570 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a district may submit a request to transfer a water right within district boundaries. OAR Chapter 690, Division 385 implements the statutes and provides the Department’s procedures and criteria for evaluating district transfer applications.

**Findings of Fact**

1. On December 19, 2012, Tumalo Irrigation District filed a district transfer application to permanently change the place of use under Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520. The Department assigned the application number T-11504.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 24, 2012, pursuant to ORS 540.580 and OAR 690-385-4400. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

**Certificate:** 74146, issued in the name of Tumalo Irrigation District

**Use:** Irrigation

**Priority Date:** June 1, 1907

**Rate & Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 1.8 acre-feet, measure at or within one-half mile of the land to be irrigated, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**Source:** Tumalo Creek, tributary to the Deschutes River

**Rate & Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands is limited as follows:

Apr 1 to May 1 and Oct 1 to Nov 1 -1/80 cfs per acre

May 1 to May 15 and Sep 15 to Oct 1 -1/60 cfs

May 15 to Sep 15 1/32.4 cfs, and 9.91 total acre-feet per acre at the diversion during the season.

**Rate & Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 1.8 acre-feet, measure at or within one-half mile of the land to be irrigated, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

**Source:** Crescent Lake Reservoir (constructed under Permit R-102), tributary to Crescent Creek.

**Use:** Supplemental Irrigation

**Priority Date:** 1905

**Rate & Duty:** The use is limited to the amount beneficially used and shall not exceed 9.50 cubic feet per second for supplemental irrigation, industrial use and pond maintenance during the irrigation season from April 1 to November 1 and storage of said water in Crescent Lake Reservoir during the non-irrigation season, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

**Source:** Deschutes River, a tributary of the Columbia River.

**Rate & Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Upper Tumalo Reservoir constructed under water use Permit R-2743.

**Source:** Tumalo Creek and Upper Tumalo Reservoir (constructed under Permit R-2743) tributaries of the Deschutes River.

**Priority Date:** December 8, 1961

**Rate & Duty:** The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 9.91 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and the right allowed hereunder for the appropriation of water for lands having a valid prior right shall be limited to the amount necessary to make up any deficiency in water available to said lands under said prior right and the amount allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for said lands, shall be limited by the duty of water as fixed herein,; and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**Sources:** Crescent Lake Reservoir (constructed under Permit R-2744), tributary of Crescent Creek and the Little Deschutes River

17. The district permanent transfer application satisfies the criteria of OAR 690-385-4000, contains the information required under OAR 690-385-2000, and includes maps meeting the

requirements of OAR 690-385-2200.

18. The water rights are subject to transfer as defined in OAR 690-385-0100(17).
19. The proposed change in place of use would not result in enlargement of the rights.
20. The proposed change in place of use would not result in injury to other water rights

### **Conclusions of Law**

The proposed changes in place of use in Transfer Application T-11504 satisfy the requirements of ORS 540.574(3) and 540.580.

### **Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:**

1. The proposed changes to the water rights evidenced by Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520 and any related decree.
3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of these water rights.
4. The proposed change, as authorized by this final order, shall be completed within one full year from the approval date plus any additional time before or until October 1, 2013.
5. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2014**. A Claim of Beneficial Use shall be submitted to the Department by Tumalo Irrigation District within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
6. Certificates 74146, 74147, 74148, 74149, 76106 and 76520 are modified. The Department will issue superseding certificates describing the right when it determines that is necessary for record keeping.
