O R D E R

On February 15, 1972, Bennie B. and Helen T. King submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

The claimed right is for the use of not to exceed 81 gallons per minute from the Brennesholtz Infiltration Trench No. 1 within the Griffin Creek Watershed, with a date of reclamation of 1954, for the irrigation of 3.35 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10.50 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, 0.60 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.20 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, all in Township 37 South, Range 2 West, W.M., and is part of the claim described in the certificate of registration recorded in Volume 5, page 907, Ground Water Registration Records.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the claim of a water right for the use of not to exceed 81 gallons per minute from the Brennesholtz Infiltration Trench No. 1 within the Griffin Creek Watershed, with a date of reclamation of 1954, for the irrigation of 3.35 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 10.50 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, 0.60 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.20 acre in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, all in Township 37 South, Range 2 West, W.M., is canceled.
