ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 4226

On May 22, 1979, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Richard Kirkham for approval of a change in place of use of water from South Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By performance under the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director approving water right transfer No. 3971, a water right now exists for the use of not to exceed 1.18 cubic feet per second of water from South Yamhill River for irrigation of a certain 8.4 acres in NW14 SW14, 28.8 acres in SW14 SW14, 7.7 acres in SE14 SW14 of Section 6; 17.4 acres in NE14 NW14, 32.0 acres in NW14 NW14 and 0.1 acre in SW14 NW14 of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; and 0.6 acre in NE14 NE14 of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M., with a date of priority of October 11, 1938.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located within the  $NE_4^1$  NE $_4^1$  of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

The applicant herein proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 4.8 acres in SW4 NW4, 0.9 acre in NW4 SW4 of Section 7, Township 6 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; 8.4 acres in NE4 NE4, 0.3 acre in NW4 NE4, 6.2 acres in SW4 NE4, 39.6 acres in SE4 NE4, 23.0 acres in NE4 SE4 and 11.8 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 12, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, W.M.

Mr. Michael F. Ladd, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO new certificate of water right be issued as provided by the order of the Water Resources Director approving transfer No. 3971; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
