ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 TO 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6231 submitted by

OAK KNOLL GOLF COURSE 6335 HIGHWAY 22 INDEPENDENCE, OREGON 97351

to use the waters of RICKREALL CREEK, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 47.4 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 13533, was perfected under Permit 13981 with a date of priority of AUGUST 18, 1939. This right is limited to 0.60 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50, SECTION 27, T 7 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 520 FEET NORTH AND 1600 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right shall conform to reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 3.9 ACRES SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.4 ACRE BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50 SECTION 22

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.7 ACRES NW 1/4 NE 1/4 20.8 ACRES SW 1/4 NE 1/4 13.9 ACRES SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.9 ACRES NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.3 ACRE NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.5 ACRES ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50 SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- 2. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. The following described lands shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 5.5 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 11.9 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 17.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 6.9 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.1 ACRES

ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 50
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

Certificate 13533 is hereby canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
