ORDER

EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The North Unit Irrigation District is the holder of permit

No. 25921 to appropriate 200.0 cubic feet per second of water from the

Crooked River for supplemental irrigation of 49,999.9 acres.

The District has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation has not been made as described in the permit, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

The District has further advised that the United States Bureau of Reclamation has conducted studies over a period of several years regarding feasibility of construction of diversion works. It is estimated that a feasible report will be completed by December 31, 1965.

It is believed that it will be consistent with public interest to grant the extension for which application has been made.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits in which to begin and complete construction work and make complete application of water under the terms of permit No. 25921 be extended to October 1, 1965.
