ORDER

EXTENDING TIME LIMITS

The City of Stayton is the holder of permit No. 29266 to a propriate 7.0 cubic feet per second of water from the North Santiam River for municipal use.

The City has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation has not been made as described in the permit, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development.

The City has further advised that construction work has not been commenced due to lack of available funds.

It is believed that it will be consistent with public interest to grant the extension for which application has been made.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the time limits in which to begin and complete construction work and make complete application of water under the terms of permit No. 29266 be extended to October 1, 1968.
