ORDER

On December 14, 1964, Newell P. Baker and Rosella Baker submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of the waters from Snow and Three Creeks for the irrigation of, among other lands, 12.7 acres in the SE_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897, and is evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 14788, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of the waters of Snow and Three Creeks for irrigation of 34.7 acres in the NW_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , and 21.7 acres in the SW_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , Section 1, Township 16 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897, is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of the waters of Snow and Three Creeks for the irrigation of 12.7 acres in the SE_{4}^{1} SW_{4}^{1} , Section 36, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1897, is canceled.
