Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.211 establishes the process in which a water right permit holder may submit a request to change the point of appropriation and/or place of use authorized under an existing water right permit.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 7, 2017, R.D. MAC, INC. filed an application to change the place of use under Permit G-13726. The Department assigned the application number T-12770.
- 2. On July 29, 2016, the Department approved an extension of time for complete application of water to October 1, 2018.
- 3. Notice of the application for the permit amendment was published in the Department's weekly notice on November 14, 2017, pursuant to ORS 540.520(5). No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 4. On August 3, 2018, the Department contacted the applicant by written correspondence to notify the applicant and the applicant's agent of the deficiencies in the application. The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by September 4, 2018.
- 5. On August 10, 2018, the Department received an Affidavit of Consent by Deeded Landowner signed by Deer Butte, LLC.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-01-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- The change does not enlarge the permit.
- 10. The change does not alter any other terms of the permit.
- 11. The proposed place of use is contiguous to the authorized place of use.

Conclusions of Law

The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12770 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.211 and the abandoned rights should be cancelled.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in place of use proposed by Permit Amendment Application T-12770 is approved. The portions of the rights that have been abandoned are cancelled.
- 2. Permit G-18101, in the name of R.D. MAC INC.; HARRY T. COLLMAN AND GREG BLACKMAN, is issued to replace Permit G-13726, and incorporates the amendments approved by this order, and the extension of time. Permit G-13726, in the name of R.D.

MAC INC.; HARRY T. COLLMAN AND GREG BLACKMAN, is no longer of any force or effect.

- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this permit.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of Permit G-18101 remain the same.
