ORDER
CANCELLING ORDER
 of May 22, 1940

On May 22, 1940, an order was entered by the State Engineer approving an application of Weaver Bond, Jesse Brown, Edna & Margaret Correll, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, Margaret K. Geddes, Gust Gekas, Holland Land Company, Estella M. Hunsaker, James & Joseph McEnroe, Guardians for Matilda McEnroe, E. B. Moeller, Henry Peyron, Florence Prowell, W. J. Robinson, State Land Board, Francis Stoddard, Chas. & Henry Wendt, and Ed York for a change in point of diversion of water from the Wisdom-Chambers ditch to the Williams-McDougal ditch, both of which divert from Powder River.

It now develops that there was a misunderstanding concerning the original application and all of the above parties, or their successors in interest, have filed petitions with the State Engineer, requesting that the order approving said application be cancelled and held for naught.

It appears that practically all of the parties signing the original application were under the impression that they were merely giving their approval to a change in point of diversion involving other rights than their own and that their rights were not actually involved. It further appears that it is a physical impossibility to deliver water thru the Williams-McDougal ditch to the lands of a large number of the original applicants.


In view of this fact and the further fact that all of the parties signing the original application, or their successors in interest, have requested

that the order of May 22, 1940, approving their application be cancelled, said order should be cancelled and held for naught, and all parties involved informed of such cancellation.

NOW THEREFORE, it hereby is ordered that the order of the State Engineer entered May 22, 1940, approving the application of Weaver Bond, Jesse Brown, Edna & Margaret Correll, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, Margaret K. Geddes, Gust Gekas, Holland Land Company, Estella M. Hunsaker, James & Joseph McEnroe, Guardians for Matilda McEnroe, E. B. Moeller, Henry Peyron, Florence Prowell, W. J. Robinson, State Land Board, Francis Stoddard, Chas. & Henry Wendt, and Ed York for a change in point of diversion from the Wisdöm-Chambers ditch to the Williams-McDougal ditch, be and the same hereby is cancelled and held for naught and that all of said parties involved be notified of the cancellation of said order.
