ORDER

Permits Nos. 3965 and 6171 were issued to the City of Hillsboro, granting the right to the use of 8 second-feet of water and 20 second-feet of water from the East Fork of Dairy Creek, respectively, for municipal use.

The time limits for the beginning and completion of construction work expired on October 1, 1937, and the time limit for the complete application of water will expire on October 1, 1940, and an application for an extension of these time limits has been filed by the City of Hillsboro.

Permits Nos. 10408, 10409 and 10410 were issued to the City of Hillsboro, granting the right to the use of 15 second-feet of water from Patton Creek, 10 second-feet of water from Gales Creek and 5 second-feet of water from Scoggins Creek, respectively, for municipal use.

The time limits for the beginning of construction work, completion of construction work and the complete application of water expired on October 1, 1937, and an application for an extension of these time limits has been filed by the City of Hillsboro.

IT IS ORDERED that the time limits for beginning and completion of construction work and complete application of water under Permits Nos. 3965, 6171, 10408, 10409 and 10410 be extended until October 1, 1942.
