ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. B-152

On December 15, 1964, Newell P. Baker and Rosella Baker filed applications for the approval of changes in places of use of water from Snow and Three Creeks and water stored in Big and Little Three Creeks Lakes, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered March 28, 1921, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Snow Creek and Three Creeks, and their Tributaries, water rights were established in the names of Frank Colfelt, Mattie A. and George A. Crawford, First National Bank of Pendleton, and Mortgage Company for America.

Water rights were established in the name of Snow Creek Irrigation District by certificates of water right recorded at pages 15359 and 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, for the storage and use of 1400 acre feet in Big Three Creek Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of March 8, 1923 and for 200 acre feet in Little Three Creek Lake Reservoir, with a date of priority of September 12, 1936, providing for primary and supplemental irrigation.

Transfer No. V-10, approved by orders of the State Engineer on December 13, 1949 and May 14, 1951, allowed a change in place of use of water from Snow and Three Creeks and water from Big and Little Three Creeks Lakes.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the applications should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed changes in place of use of water are approved and the water rights described in TABULATION A be served therefrom and without loss of priority be transferred to irrigation of those lands described in TABULATION B.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the water rights described in TABULATION C be severed therefrom and without loss of priority be transferred to supplemental irrigation of those lands described in TABULATION D.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in place of use is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificates recorded at pages 14785, 14786, 14788, 14790 and 14797, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and certificate recorded at page 15360, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled, and that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificates of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
