ORDER APPROVING CHANGES IN PLACE OF USE (PRIORITY SWITCH)

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6939 submitted by

SCHUDEL ENTERPRISES 800 NW CORNELL CORVALLIS, OREGON 97330 MARTYN AND DOROTHY BOEHM 8590 PARKER ROAD INDEPENDENCE, OREGON 97351.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 49078, was perfected under Permit 20830 with a date of priority of OCTOBER 26, 1951. The right allows the use of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.4 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.13 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, as projected within VANDERPOOL DLC 63, T 9 S, R 4 W, WM; 10 FEET NORTH AND 5680 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER VANDERPOOL DLC 63, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 49079, was perfected under Permit 35334 with a date of priority of JUNE 11, 1971. The right allows the use of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.4 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.08 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: NE¼ SW¼, SECTION 20, as projected within VANDERPOOL DLC 63, T & S, R 4 W, WM; 10 FEET NORTH AND 5680 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER VANDERPOOL DLC 63, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITION IS MET BY THE WATER USERS:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.

Certificates 49078 and 49079 are cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
