### **Authority**

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

### **Findings of Fact**

## Background

- 1. On September 11, 2006, Fred and Elizabeth Mueller filed an application to change the points of appropriation under Certificates 24171 and 28240. The Department assigned the application number T-10238.
- 2. Pan American Berry Growers LLC, 6586 55th Avenue NE, Salem, Oregon 97305, has been designated as a receiving landowner.
- 3. On September 2, 2009, the applicant sent revised pages of the application with corrected well location descriptions.
- 4. On October 7, 2009, the applicant submitted a letter from Pan American Berry Growers requesting an additional point of appropriation for the remaining portion of Certificate 28240.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

11. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 17, 2006, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

- 12. On October 14, 2009, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10238 to the applicants. The cover letter for the draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of November 13, 2009, for the applicants to respond. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 13. On November 24, 2009, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10238 and mailed a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on December 1, 2009, and in the Woodburn Independent newspaper on December 16, 23, and 30, 2009, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

### Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 14. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 15. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights was present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-10238.
- 16. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 17. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

#### Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation and additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10238 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

### Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The change in points of appropriation and additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10238 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 24171 and 28240 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificates 24171 and 28240 are cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to describe that portion of the right described by Certificate 24171 not affected by this transfer.

- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation for the right described by Certificate 24171, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation under the right described by Certificate 24171.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the proposed additional point of appropriation (Well 2), together with that diverted at the original point of diversion (Well 1), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation under the right described by Certificate 28240.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 8. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2011**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. When satisfactory proof of the completed changes is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
