ORDER APPROVING ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6531 submitted by

PAUL JENSEN
JB SOD AND SEED
5289 BLUEGRASS LANE
SILVERTON, OREGON 97381.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 42313, was perfected under Permit G-4203 with a date of priority of JUNE 24, 1968. The right allows the use of A WELL, a tributary of MILL CREEK (PUDDING RIVER), for IRRIGATION OF 169.9 ACRES. The right is limited to 1.05 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within RODDE DLC 57, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, WM; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 40 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, HOVENDEN DLC 76, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to add points of appropriation to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within HOVENDEN DLC 76, SECTION 28, T 4 S, R 1 W, WM; WELL 2 - 90 FEET NORTH AND 480 FEET WEST, WELL 3 - 1430 FEET NORTH AND 570 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE CENTER $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 28.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificate 42313 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
