Transfer Application 4019, in the name of Lyle Woodcock, proposed a change in place of use of water from Scroggs Spring and Maple Gulch under a certain right with a priority date of April 13, 1939, to irrigate a certain 4.5 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM.

Said application also proposed a change in place of use of water from Woodcock Reservoir under a certain right with a priority date of August 9, 1963, to irrigate a certain 5.6 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 35, Township 37 South, Range 5 West, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered October 12, 1978, approving Transfer Application 4019, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1980."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the subject water right was lost.
