ORDER

WHEREAS, the city of Milton is the holder of Permit No. 7850 to appropriate 100 second-feet of water from the South Fork of the Walla Walla River for power, domestic and municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS, said city has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation described in this permit has not been made, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development which will probably be made in the not too distant future,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for beginning and completion of construction work and complete application of water to beneficial use under this permit be and the same is hereby extended until October 1, 1936.
